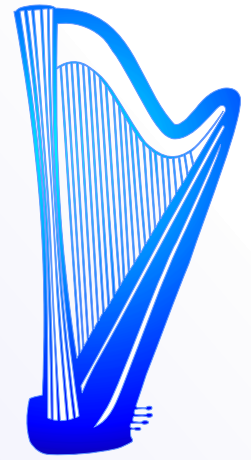


Thank you for considering my harp music. Here is a listing of some of my classical, sacred and traditional repertoire for concert harp and for Celtic harp.
